Come a day early!



the stage, we have arranged two happenings (optional, of course, and at no additional cost) for those who wish to participate.

On Thursday evening after dinner, we invite you to join us at historic Christ Church Frederica (c. 1884), just twelve minutes by auto from the Epworth campus, and gracing the grounds where there has been almost-continuous worship since General James Edward Oglethorpe landed on St. Simons In February, 1736, bringing John and Charles Wesley with him. There you will experience an outstanding example of “re-imagining the traditional”: X Church, a candle-lit, meditative, choral service just completing its third year as a regular feature at Christ Church.

In addition to adding music to each session of January Adventure 2018, on Friday morning, Owen & Moley Ó Súilleabháin and Noririn Ní Riain will lead a discussion on Celtic Spirituality, opening doors to new ways of thinking. This will be held at Lovely Lane Chapel (c. 1880) on the Epworth campus.
